→ Student Services

We serve all Washington Union High School students grades 9-12. ASP operates Monday through Friday from 3:15pm-6:15pm .

A free daily snack is provided.

Program elements include daily academic support in core subject areas including homework assistance. Rotating enrichment activities include but are not limited to, career education, mentoring and tutoring, arts, computer training, intramural sports, and fitness. Weekly schedules are available in the front office.

→ Code of Conduct

WUHS ASP provides a disciplined, stimulating learning climate. Consistent with the instructional day, The WUHS ASP uses Positive Behavioral and Intervention Supports (PBIS) and promotes Washington High's P.A.W (Pride, Attitude, Work Hard)

Safety

→ ASP staff are easily identifiable by their program shirts and visible ID badges.

Formal/informal safety drills are conducted in coordination with the instructional day.

Bullying incidents and school safety threats can be reported to ASP coordinator, administration or ASP staff.

→ Program Access

ASP operates at Washington Union High School immediately following each instructional day. Students can enter and exit the campus from several crosswalk locations on Lincoln Ave. and Elm Ave.

ASP students report to their desired ASP program following the instructional day. Afterwards, they sign in for an activity. At the close of each activity, students sign out and choose another activity or exit the program. Mobile snack cart comes around to each program for easy accessibility to all students.

Occasional field trips and community service activities take place off-site. For occasions such as these, round-trip transportation for field trips is provided. Students are escorted by ASP staff or school buses are utilized for community service and mentoring activities during program hours. Parent permission is required for all off-site activities.
